



## Our pools are a special treat for all residents to enjoy.

- 1. Everyone must have a resident badge with them at the pool or a guest pass.
- 2. No glass containers in pool area or on the pool deck. No food and drinks in pool.
- 3. No inappropriate language
- 4. <u>Toddlers in diapers are not allowed in the pool</u>.
- 5. If you have open wounds, etc. PLEASE DON'T use the pool.
- 6. Proper swim attire is required, no street clothes.
- 7. No Running or jumping around the pool or into the pool.
- 8. Floats are not allowed, noodles are.
- 9. Noodles are allowed however they cannot have the extensions attached.
- 10. All guest under the age of 35 years old must leave the pool by 1:00pm
