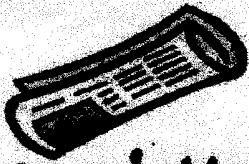

POOL RULES

Must be in possession of a resident badge or a guest badge. Guest must be accompanied by a resident at all times. Children under 10 are not required to have a pass.

* Pool opens at 8am.

* Pool closes at dusk.

* The only approved flotation device is a Pool noodle

* There are NO GLASS CONTAINERS allowed at either pool.

* No drinks or drink containers are allowed in the pool or the deck.

* Keep all shoes and personal possessions out of the Safe Zone around the pool.

* Please rinse off before entering Pool.

* No diapers allowed in the pool.

* All guest under the age of 35 must leave the pool by 1pm.
