

## Today's Hearing on Motion for Summary Judgement

First of all, a big thank you to everyone who attended! We had over 100 people there: about 40 seated in the court room, about 40 standing in the courtroom, and over 20 standing in the hall at the doorway.



Alan Bobo, the attorney for the Wynne Building Corporation, made arguments on his motion for summary judgement to dismiss. We were represented by Atty. David Holley from Bob Burandt's office. I believe that our stronger case won more points with the judge than opposing counsel did. (A couple of times statements made by Atty. Bobo resulted in laughter from the assembled park residents.) It is also my opinion that it can be argued that documented facts do not support several statements Atty. Bobo made.

I have heard a couple of different opinions about what comes next. I have my own opinion of what I heard and what I think it means. Next week we will have a conference call between the three presidents and our attorneys. Rather than muddy the waters with potentially misleading statements, I will wait until after that conference call and then lay out where we are and what comes next.

After this hearing, it is my firm belief that Judge Belanger is impartial and wants to make the right decision. The bottom line, at this time, is this: I feel really good right now!
