

Silent Auction

A Silent Auction is where a variety of items are offered where people bid on them by writing down what they would spend on the item on the designated Silent Auction Day.

The bidder can also check on the offers for items they are really interested in and enter an additional bid before the closing time of the Silent Auction.

For example: We devise a letter from the HOA, and we go around to local vendors to solicit items that would be used every day- Oil Changes, Tire Rotations, Dry Cleaning Service, Lunch for two, Dinner for two, Complimentary appetizer, Hair Salon Service, Gift Cert from Grocer, Car Rental discount, etc.

The more the better; even tangible items from a person or a company.

And the HOA will provide a certificate which the donor can display thanking them for their donation and support.

Raffles

Another Way to raise money for the HOA is with raffles.

This can be for:

Big Items: Car, Boat, Cruise, Airfare, Train or travel, Bus travel, Golf Cart, House Painting, etc.

Minor Items: Lawn Mower, Golf Caddy Cart, etc.

Small Items: Rifle, Handgun, Golf Clubs, Dishware, Pots N Pans, Door Dash, Grub Hub delivery, etc.

When doing raffles, you would need to sell enough tickets to cover the expense unless the item was donated to you to sell.
