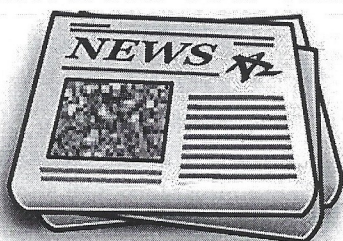

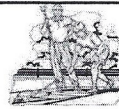

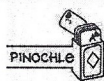

4th place: John Nabozny, Rob Harding, Jim Michelin, Nancy Migneault

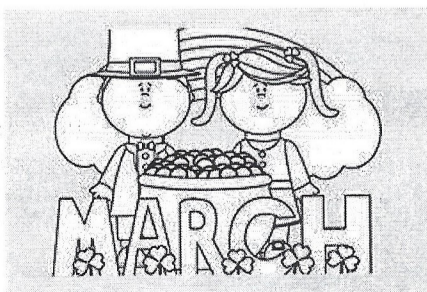
