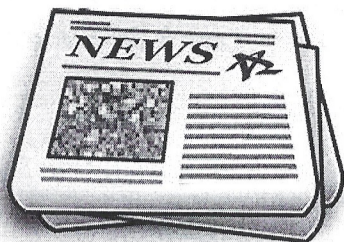

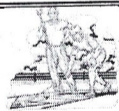

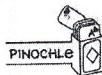

**Recent legislation about golf cart
operation.**

A new law takes effect in Florida on
October 1, 2023, imposing the following
Restrictions on golf cart operators:

- Instead of permitting anyone 14 years and older to operate a golf cart, the new legislation requires operators younger than 18 to have valid driver's or learner's permit.
- Operators at least 18 years old may operate golf carts as long as they have a valid driver's license or another form of government- issued photo identification.

*The pool closes at dusk.
