As you are aware, our firm represents Plaintiffs, Spanish Lakes Country Club Village Homeowner's Association, Inc. and Spanish Lakes-Golf Village Homeowners Association, Inc. with regard to the above-referenced matter.

It came to our attention that Wynne Building Corporation ("Wynne") has been threatening residents in Spanish Lakes with eviction if they do not cure certain alleged violations on their property.
